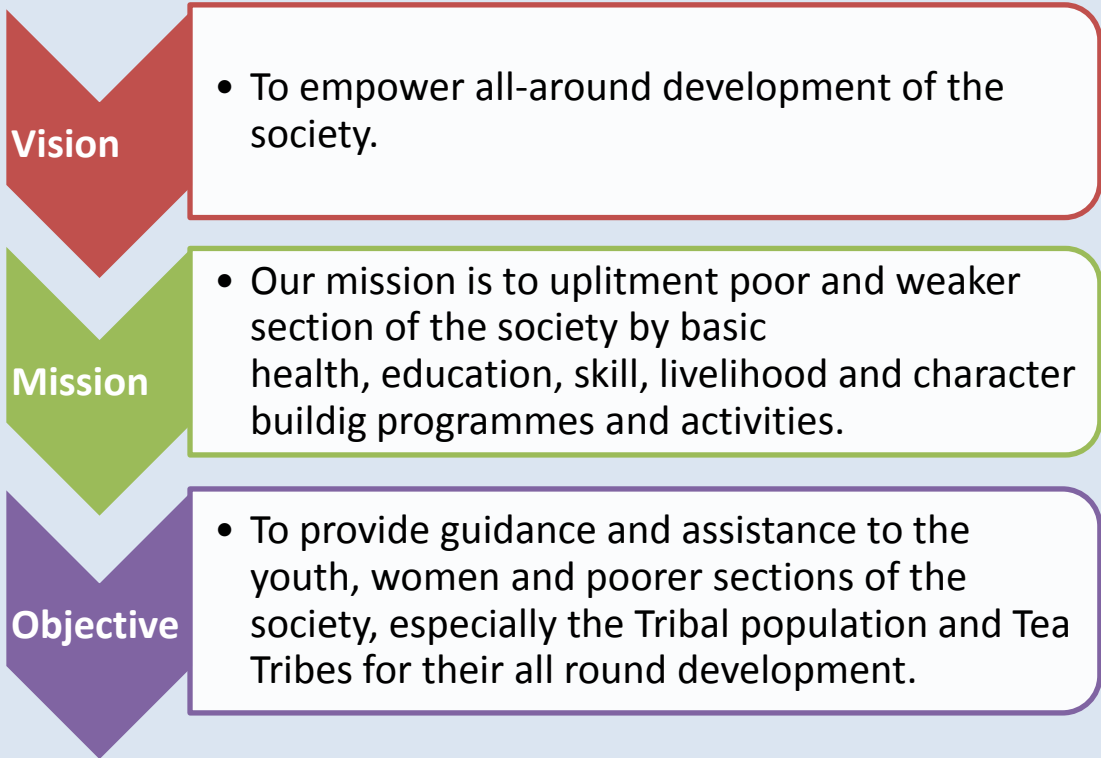

Besides the medical camps SBP also distributed food & drinking water among the flood victims.

Seva Bharati, Purbanchal had organised mass marriage program for the under-privilege couples, in last year about 1400 such marriages were conducted in four locations namely: Rangapar, Biswanath Charai, Doomdoma & Morigaon.

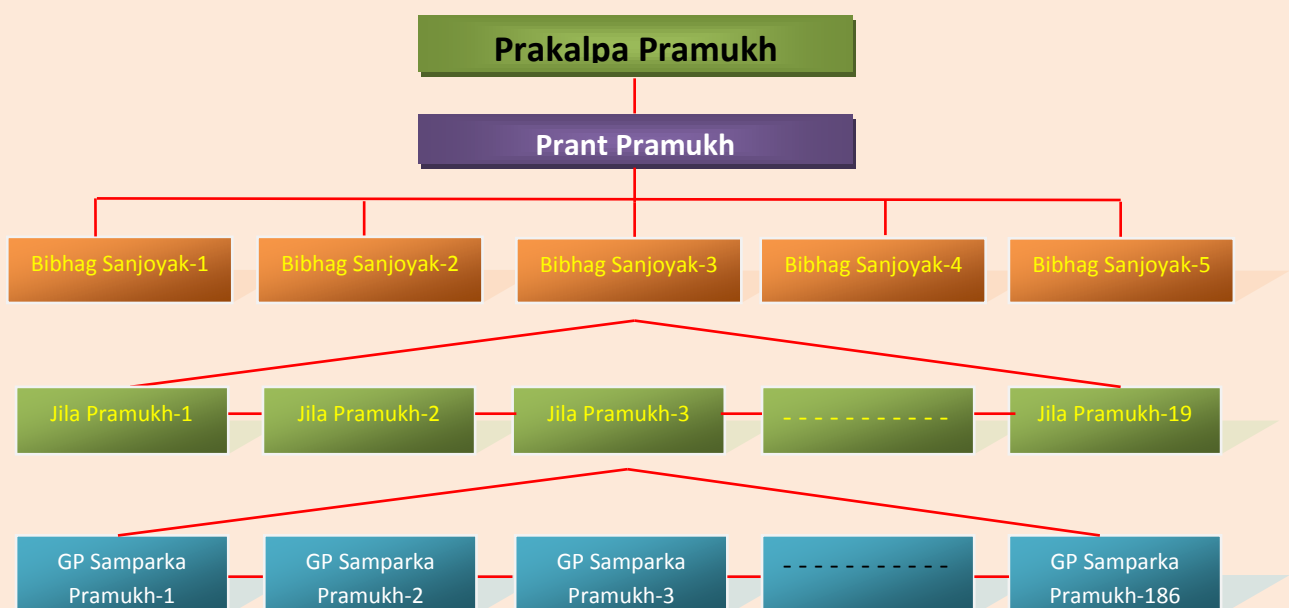
AROGYA MITRA PROJECT

“AROGYA MITRA” project is aims to reach the remotest villages for providing primary health care and awareness to the rural and downtrodden people. “Arogya Mitra” (AM) Project is one of most the successful projects of Seva Bharati, Purbanchal. Under this project, an Arogya Mitra (health worker) voluntarily provides free primary health care facilities for daily minimum one hour to the people of his or her locality. There are 3220 Arogya Mitras providing services in various district of Assam.

ORGANISATIONAL STRUCTURE OF AROGYA MITRA PROJECT:



A. AROGYA MITRA PRIMARY TRAINING CAMP:

Arogya Mitra Training Camps are organized to train the selected local people of remote areas as a health worker. They are imparted trainings locality wise throughout the year bringing them in a nearest place for a 7 days residential camp. Trainings are given on the health related topics such as Anatomy, primary medicine, disease preventive measures, sanitation, hygiene, first aid and basic yoga etc. This year three training camps was organized in three places of Assam, where 58 Arogya Mitras participated.

**B. AROGYA MITRA PRAGATI VARG:**

Arogya Mitra PragatiVarg is an advance training course for experience Arogya Mitras who have a minimum experience of consulting 500 patients. Pragati Varg usually held in every two years.

C. FREE MEDICAL CAMPS:

Free medical camps are organized by Arogya Mitras in various remote villages with the help of volunteer of SBP and doctors, medical college students and local persons. Through health check-up camps free medicines are provided to the economically weaker and downtrodden sections of the Society. This year, 1767 patients have benefited from 23 Free Medical Camps of 11 different districts of Assam.

**D. HEALTH AWARENESS AND SANITATION PROGRAMME:**

The awareness programme organized by Arogya Mitras in different villages to discuss health related matters for maintaining good health in the society. In Health Awareness and sanitation programme, the Arogya Mitras discuss and interact with

the different sections of villagers together with invited health related resource persons. The awareness programme also includes sanitation and cleanness topics for discussion especially on preventive measures for a healthy environment. A total 12 nos of health awareness camps organized in this year.



E. AM GRAM PANCHAYAT LEVEL MONTHLY MEETING:

Gram Panchayat level Monthly meetings are organised by AMGP Samparkar Pramukh (Sampark Pramukh is a head of a GP). In a GP, a group of Arogya Mitras consisting of 12 to 15 nos. of both man and women. In this meeting, Arogya Mitras are submit report of previous month and discuss about various related issues for strengthen themselves for better services including planning of next month. In this year, 66 meeting has been conducted covering 20 Districts of Assam.



F. DISTRICT WISE AM GP SAMPARK PRAMUKH MEETING:

District wise meetings are held among the Sampark Pramukhs in the respective district. Sampark Pramukhs meeting is organised monthly or bi-monthly. In this year, 19 nos of district level meeting was organised.



G. AROGYAM:

Arogyam is a health education and character building programme for age group of 4 to 14 years children. It is one hour programme for one or two days in a week. The Arogyam is conducted by women Arogya Mitras specially trained for the purpose and held in a specific place through playing, singing, and storytelling. Presently 10 centres in interior locations of Assam.



H. KISHORI VIKAS:

It is a one day monthly programme for teenage girls of a village organised by Female Arogya Mitras to discuss various topics of teenage girls relating to maintenance of their health, character, security, women education and other problems relating to their age group. Presently 4 nos of Kishori vikas Kendra running in different places in Assam.



I. MATRI MANDALI:

Matri Mandali programmes organise to strengthen the adult women of the society. It is one day monthly programme organised by mainly female Arogya Mitras to discuss the problems relating to child birth, child care, socio-economic development, sanitation, social awareness etc.



J. NIRAMAYA:

Niramaya Project: Integrated Child and Adolescent Development Action project was initiated from April, 2017 under Arogya Mitra project with the support of **Infosys Foundation**- a charity organization based in Bangalore. Niramaya project provides free health and education services to ensure practice of healthy lifestyle practice and treatment in villages. Niramaya covers 200 villages of 18 Districts in Assam and 40 community Field Officers are working in different district of Assam.

To accomplish the objectives of Niramaya, Community- based intervention is followed to have Niramaya provide maximum benefit to the villagers

APPROACHS OF NIRAMAYA:



Niramaya Project Implementation & Management: A team of dedicated Community Field Officers (CFOs) who were previously engaged in Arogya Mitra project working selflessly for social up-liftment were engaged in Niramaya Project. Besides, these CFOs, 600 Village Volunteers were also selected from villages for implementation of Niramaya programmes, those were willing to work voluntarily for these social cause. Further, in the project management unit also comprises of project manager, project coordinator, Technical assistant who are managing and monitoring all the work of Niramaya at the field level.

As the PRA and Baseline Survey was conducted in last financial year, this year 2018-19 other component of the project was carried out such as Health Screening of Child and Adolescent and Health and Life Skill Education programme at villages organized along with Training of Trainers programme.



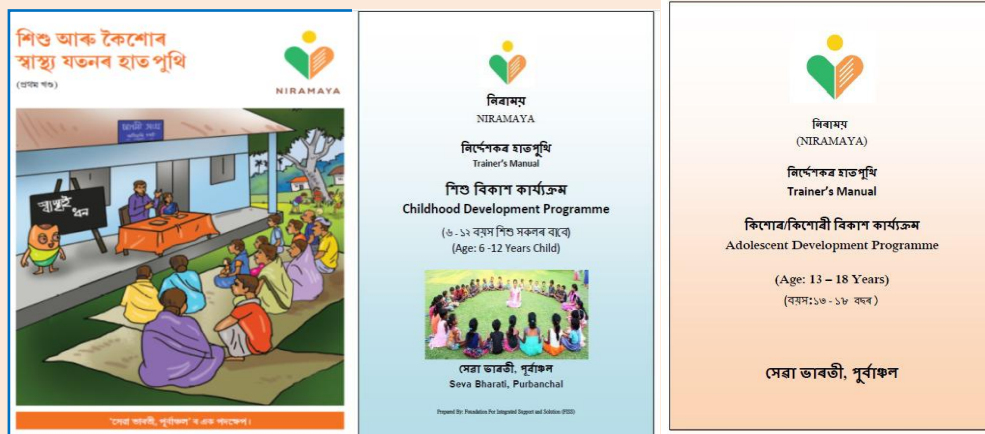

CONTENT DEVELOPMENT:

To implement the objectives of Niramaya, content and teaching manuals has developed for respective workshops and programmes of Child, Adolescents health and Mothers health care development.

MANUALS:

HEALTH SCREENING:

Health Screening was one of the important parts of community intervention aspects of Niramaya project covering all the children and Adolescents. Health screening survey done by Health Screening Questionnaires form. In the form questionnaires are made to identify health status of selected villages and to identify health status of each child and adolescent of the community. Questionnaires consist of questions related to Nutrition deficiency (MUAC, BMI) and other Deficiencies, Birth defect, Diseases, Developmental Delay and Adolescent problems. The questionnaires responses filled by direct observation and Testing of some parameter by medical equipments. A **Health Card** containing health information was given to every children and adolescents of villages after Health Screening.

HEALTH SCREENING DETAILS:

- Health Screening completed in **82** villages.
- Health Screening covered total **8591** Child and Adolescents.
- **521** Individual identified as a Special case during screening.

During health screening survey, the recorded diseases are mainly birth defect, Deficiency, Developmental Delay etc. The special care Children were suggested to refer to nearby associated hospital or health centre for further treatment as per Govt. health schemes. One Central Govt. health scheme called RBSK (Rastriya Baal Swatha Karyakram), provide special treatment for Child and Adolescents. Every Development Block has their Mobile Doctors team. The assigned CFO visited the Block Level RBSK offices and provided the list of identified special cases to the RBSK Officers for treatment. At present, 129 special individual screened by RBSK team and 8 individual completed treatment and 99 are in treatment process under RBSK scheme.

PROGRAMME ON HEALTH AND LIFE SKILL EDUCATION:

To raise awareness on health, skill development, livelihood, and social issues, focusing mainly on mother and child's health, Mother and Child Health Programme and Social Awareness programme organized in all villages. The programmes were conducted in the village through Community Field Officers (CFOs). To run the programme more effectively, 600 village volunteers were engaged i.e. 3 for each village (1 for MCHP, 1 for CDP and 1 for ADP) who were trained by the trained CFOs of Niramaya programme.

CHILDHOOD DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME:

The activity program is to be on children empowerment in a particular village. Community Field Officer organizes weekly one hour activity program among the children of the village on singing, dancing, gamming, storytelling, hands on learning, science related activities, and many other activities. There would be a number of hands on learning activity and career counseling sessions for the children.

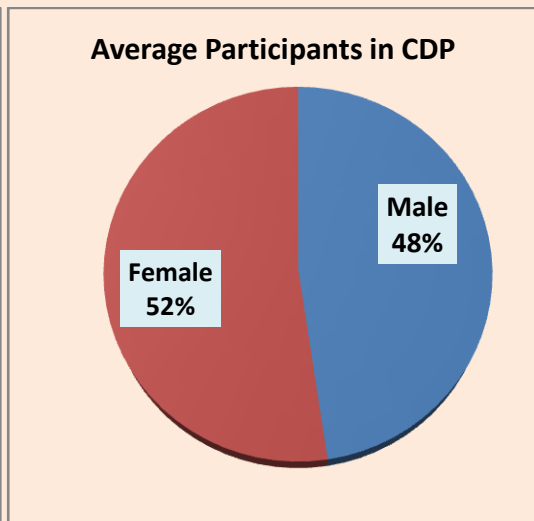
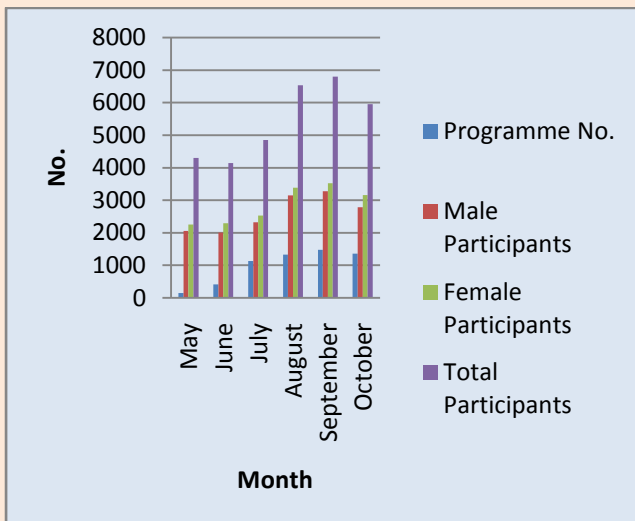


Figure 1. Male and Female Participants in CDP Figure 2. Programme and Participants in CDP

Childhood Development Programme organized in Saturdays for 4-5 Year Age Child and Sundays for 6-12 Year Age Children in a week. A total 5855 no. of Childhood Development programme organized in villages from May, 2018 to October, 2018 (Figure 1). In these programme 6796 nos of Child participated of which Male 3272 nos participants and Female 3524 nos participants. The average participants present in CDP programmes are 5429 nos. (Male- 2600 nos and Female- 2857 nos) (Figure 2).

ADOLESCENT DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME:

Aatmabhaan- Kishor/Kishori Vikas: Aatmabhaanis a program for the development of adolescent girls (kishori) and boys (kishor). Habits and behavior picked up during adolescence (risk taking behavior, substance abuse, eating habits and conflict resolution) have a lifelong impact, so it is important to make sure that these habits are beneficial to one's well-being. Aatmabhaan program is designed to address this by educating adolescent girls & boys about their well-being and raising physical/ mental health awareness.

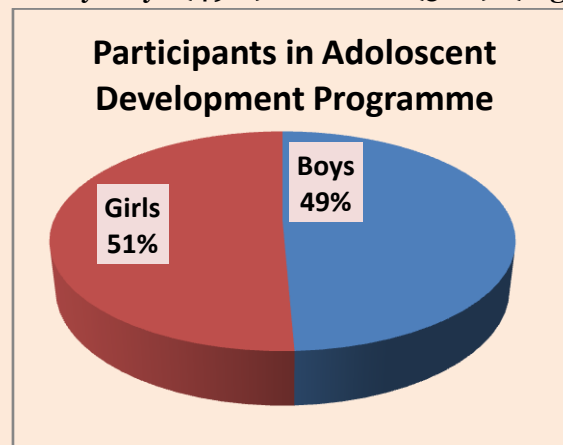


Figure 3: Male and Female Participants in ADP

The foundation of Aatmbhaan has been set and it would be extremely beneficial to conduct it by Community Field Officer. The Adolescent Development Programme organizes fortnightly in a month for both Boys and Girls group. A total of 2421 No. of Adolescent Development programme organized in the selected area. The programme participated by Boys (49%) and Girls (51%). (Figure 3).

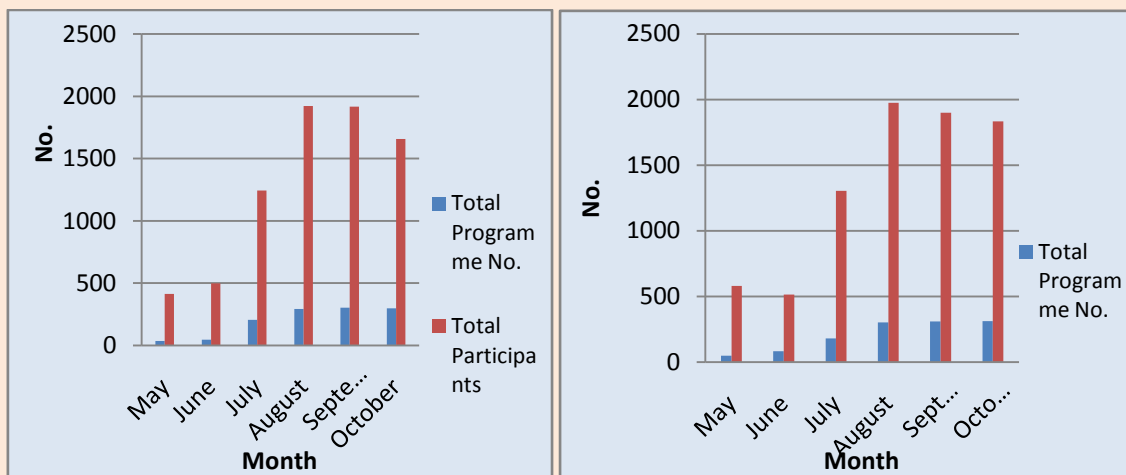
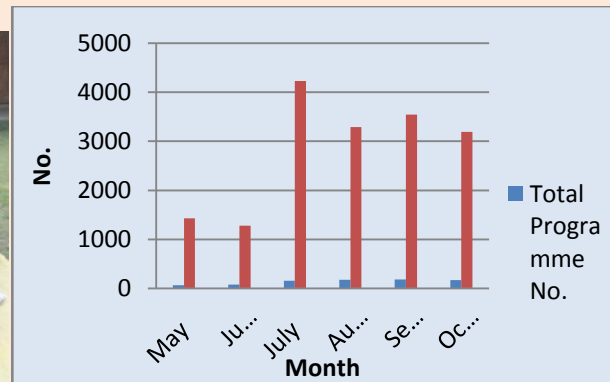


Figure 4: Details of Programme and Participants in ADP for Boys, Figure 5: Details of Programme and Participants in ADP for Girls

A total of 1181 Nos of Adolescent Development Programme for Boys (Kishor Bikash) organized in all respective villages (Figure 4). All over 1922 nos of participants participated in these programmes. A total of 1240 Nos of Adolescent Development Programme for Girls (Kishori Bikash) organized in respective villages. All over 1975 nos of participants participated in these programmes (Figure 5).

MOTHER AND CHILD HEALTH DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME:

Mother and Child Health programme (MCHP) deliver the awareness on child nourishment issues mainly breastfeeding, childhood diseases, immunization, nutrition monitoring and pregnancy. The MCHP programme organized once in a month per village. The participants are mostly the mothers of Child and Adolescents in the same village. The programme conducted by the Community Field Officer and assigned Village Volunteers. A total 837 Mother and Child Health programme organized from May, 2018 to October, 2018 (Figure 6). Till now 4233 Mothers were participated in these programmes.

YOG AND NATUROPATHY INSTITUTE:

Seva Bharati, Purbanchal founded a “Yog and Naturopathy Institute” by re-constructing “**YOGNILAYAM**” – a residential Yog Education, Training and Naturopathy Treatment Centre with financial support from ONGC. It is well equipped with modern equipment’s, where qualified and experienced Yog teachers and Naturopathy Doctors and experts render their services to train and treat the people. Yog Education and Training related courses such as Diploma in Yog Education (D.Y.Ed.), Yog and Naturopathy treatment Training Course, 7 Day Yog Shivar Course (Introductory) etc.

The Yognilayam was inaugurated on January, 2019 in presence of chief guest Mananiya Shri Bhaiya Ji Joshi, Sara Kariyah, Rashtriya Swamesavak Sangha and Officials of ONGC, NE Zone along with other dignitaries and resource persons.

YOG CENTRE:

Seva Bharati, Purbanchal running 66 Yog Centre covering 21 districts of Assam. The Yog centres facilitate regular practices of Yog to local people with Yogacharyas. Total of 1705 people including women and child benefitted from the Yog Centers in this year.

Seva Bharati, Purbanchal also conducting Block Level Yog Centre in 17 Development Blocks covering 7 districts of Assam with the financial assistance from AYUSH Department, Government of Assam. Every Block Yog Centre conducting regular classes by engaging both Male and Female Yog Teachers by Seva Bharati, Purbanchal. The local people of Blocks benefitted from this centre by participating in the Yog classes.

ONE TEACHER SCHOOL PROJECT:

To empower of children's through Education of the remotest areas of North East, Seva Bharati, Purbanchal initiated Free Study Centre namely **One Teacher School** project for rural community students. The project is sponsored by Sewa Canada Sponsored Project. This project is for establishing schools in less schooling facility area to promote, support and grow awareness towards education among the students and parents. This is especially executed in tribal and Tea garden areas in Assam. Presently **32 one teacher schools** are running and **total students are 799.**

Objective of One Teachers School project:

1. To provide basic facilities for study to the childrens
2. To provide education in rural places
3. To provide education support to childrens of poor families
4. To developed self sustain education process in their own places
5. To provide character building based education

SKILL AND LIVELIHOOD DEVELOPMENT

Seva Bharati, Purbanchal working to generate maximum livelihood option for villagers and poor people of rural area in Assam as well as in North East region. The livelihood option may generate more income opportunities for the families facing financial problems. Due their financial obstacle, they unable to avail good education, good health, sufficient daily home uses along other basic needs. The North Eastern region facing problem of income generation from long back. But, the region also have various opportunities for livelihood option.

With the possibilities of livelihood option Seva Bharati, Purbanchal initiated livelihood development projects and programme in various fields. The livelihood development programme also includes Skill development training for better development processes. The livelihood and skill development programme facilitates self-employment generation also which may solve the basic problems facing by the downtrodden families of rural areas.

The livelihood development programmes includes Gram Vikas Yojana- a village development project, Silai, Bamboo craft training, Computer training etc.

1. GRAM VIKAS YOJANA:

Gram Vikash Yojana is a village development programme to transform a village into a self-dependent village by organizing various village level meetings, awareness and training programme among the village people. The Seva Bharati, Purbanchal takes various steps to make people self-reliable and sustainable in our traditional ways using modern technologies. With importance of gram vikas project Seva Bharati, Purbanchal set up a centre at Dalgaon, Darraang (Assam).

2. SILAI PRAKALPA (TAILORING):

Silai and Hastakala is one of the good opportunities for livelihood to generate more income and create self-employment possibilities in Assam. So, Seva Bharati, Purbanchal organised Silai and Hastakala training in various places in Assam. The training programme mostly trained women with the view of women empowerment.

Highlights:

- Creating self-employment opportunities through Silai.
- In this financial year 25 nos of women trained by organising 3 Silai Training Camp.
- SBP also organised a training camp on Jute Bag Manufacture.
- Multiple nos. of training Centres of tailoring, embroidery are exist throughout the NE Region
- Supporting 02 production centres
- Supporting Self Help Groups



4. BAMBOO CRAFT:

Bamboo Craft training also organised by Seva Bharati, Purbanchal to enhance self-employment opportunity for rural inhabitants. The growing bamboo based marketing is helpful for the trained individuals.



5. COMPUTER TRAINING CENTRE:

The Seva Bharati, Purbanchal provides skill development training on Computer education to empower youth. The training on computer is very much useful and essential for employment in maximum job opportunities. To facilitate computer training, Seva Bharati, Purbanchal set up a computer centre in Gossaigaon, Kokrajhar, where several students enrolled in various courses such as Certificate on Computer Application (CCA), Diploma in Computer Application (DCA), Tally, DTP etc.

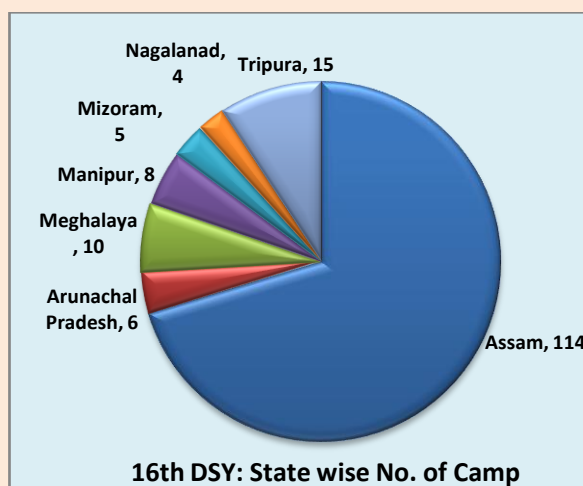

VALEDICTORY SESSION:

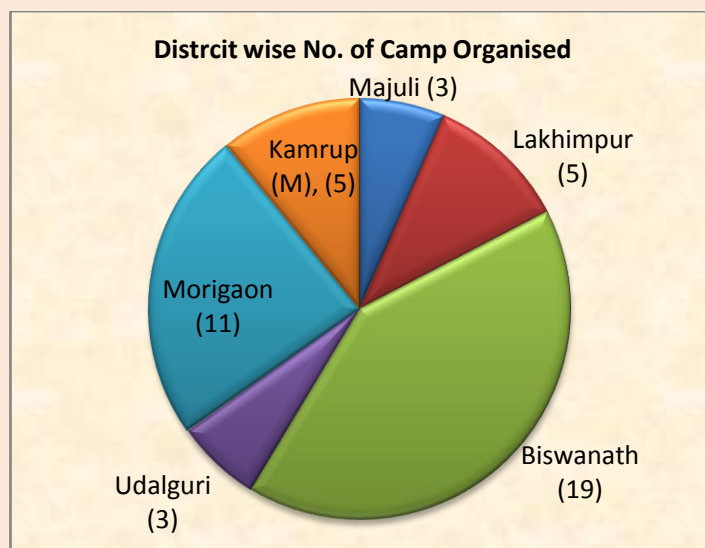

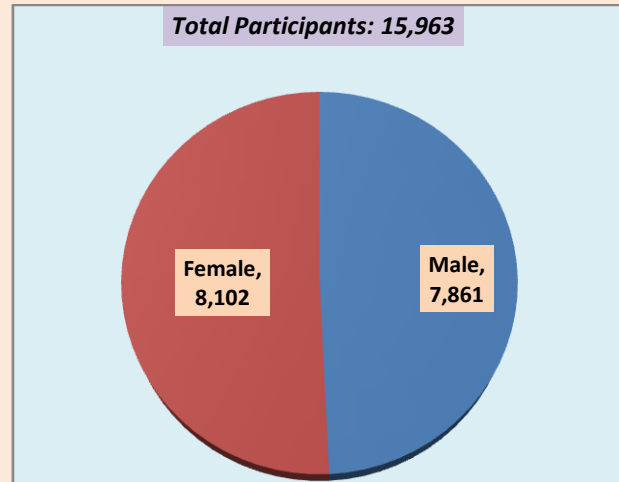

SAMUHIK VIVAH (Mass Marriage)

Seva Bharati, Purbanchal (SBP) arranges Samuhik Vivah (Mass Marriage) in Assam to support the financially and socially regressive population of our society who are willing to get marriage by observing all the rituals followed by their respective society but unable due to pecuniary difficulties. This Mass marriage institution of SBP has helped the individuals to maintain the social customs followed by their society and cultural values observed by their respective communities. Couples who remain unmarried due to social and financial difficulties, get immensely benefited out of the Mass Marriage program organized by Seva Bharati, Purbanchal.

In some area, due to unsocial marriages, couples are not recognised by their society and they are not allowed to take part in any social & religious functions of the community. Those couple are unable to arrange social marriage for their financial problem and remain same for a long time. All such couple gets immense benefit of the Mass Marriage program of SBP.

The mass marriage program organized by SBP, is helping the society to overcome the socio-cultural issues besides financial difficulties. Through the mass marriage institution, the needy couples get the opportunity satisfy themselves as well as their society / community in observing the marriage rituals.

The mass marriage institutions are conducted by SBP is almost free of cost to needy couples. SBP also offers a gift to the wedded couple which comprise of a set of household Utensil a Bag, an Umbrella, Cloths etc.

The mass marriages organised in association with 'Sevaayan' and 'Dharma Jagaran Mancha'. A total of **1305 couple** was engaged through samuhik vivah programme. The mass marriages were organized in four places in Assam comprising Biswanath, Tinsukia, Sonitpur and Morigaon districts in this year.

RANGAPARA: Mass marriage held at Rangapara in Sonitpur district on 03-02-2019, where 398 couples get married. The bride and grooms mostly belong to Tea tribe community along with other communities. The bride and grooms have come from all across Sonitpur district. Hon'ble Minister of Assam Shri Pallab Lochan Das (now MP) and other dignitaries such as Kumud Borthakur, Manik Das, Surendra Talkhedkar were present.

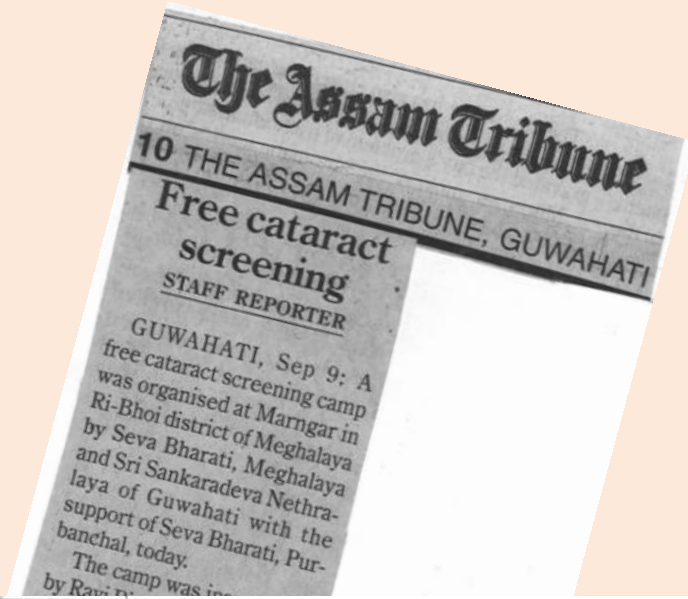
